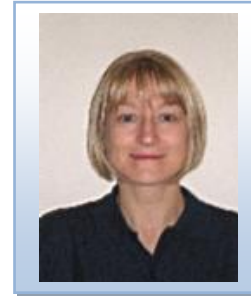




Interview with a vet
